



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The Directive Organization of **CLUB NÁUTICO SANTA POLA** has assumed the commitment of performing the activities and services offered by C. N. Santa Pola in a way that guarantees the satisfaction of its members and customers by respecting the natural environment. In order to fulfil this commitment, it describes its environmental policy based on the following statements:

- Developing a series of strategies that define the necessary performing patterns to carry out a correct management of our activities and services according to the requisites demanded by rule ISO 14001:2004.
- Establishing initiatives to ensure the accomplishment of the environmental rules and regulations, as well as the fulfilment of its members and clients' demands or other environmental requisites applicable to the activities performed in the club. Therefore, it will promote the involvement of all the staff and customers in the protection and improvement of the littoral we are in, by means of sensitisation and instructive devices, and by focusing on a communicative approach at every possible level.
- Establishing the necessary technical and economical means to stop pollution and prevent it from its roots, as well as to prevent and remove –as far as it is possible– every potential impact, derived from its activities, on the natural environment.
- Ensuring a special following in every activity and service available, creating strategies of continuous improvement to guarantee the progression as in the quality of the natural environment around C. N. Santa Pola, as in its services.
- Defining and evaluating natural environmental targets regularly, in order to boost the continuous enhancement in our activities and services.

This policy must be spread from the Directive Organization to the staff, members and customers of CLUB NÁUTICO SANTA POLA so, once assumed, can be applied and updated by everyone.
